Coggins within 12 months required for all horses and out-of-state horses also require health certificate. CCI3*/CCI2* Foreign Horses must be in possession of an FEI Passport. CCI3* U.S. Horses must be in possession of an FEI Passport. CCI2* U.S. Horses may have either a FEI Passport or a USEF National Passport. All passports must contain proof of vaccination against influenza, signed by a veterinarian in accordance with FEI rules. All riders and horses must be registered with the FEI. Sampling Procedure for Prohibited Substances (Vet Regs, Ch. V&VI and Annex IV) Regular sampling is carried out in CCI4/3*, CCI0s, World Cup Qualifiers and Finals, Championships and Games, whereas at other CCIs sampling is recommended. When testing takes place, the number of horses tested is at the discretion of the Testing Veterinary/ Veterinary Delegate; however, a minimum of three is recommended (Vet Reg. Art. 1016)

DRESSAGE: *Test and arena size:* **CCI3*** - 2009 FEI three-star Event Test B- Standard, **CCI2*** - 2009 FEI Two-star Event Test B, **CIC3***-2009 FEI Three-star Test A-Std. - Standard. *Arenas:* All weather footing.

CROSS COUNTRY: **CCI3*** - 5700 @ 570 mpm. **CCI2*** - 4500 @ 550 mpm. **CIC3*** - 5400m @ 570 mpm. *Courses:* Average for horses with some experience at this level.
