Rules & General Information

- 1. Entry Fee is \$15 per class. Non-refundable office fee \$10 Phone for day of show 609-259-1881
- 2. Schooling pass \$15 where noted.
- 3. Non-competing horses \$15 grounds fee, including schooling; Back number required for all horses
- 4. Negative Coggins required within 2 years
- 5. Show is held rain or shine!
- 6. Ribbons to 6th Place plus Champion and Reserve for each Division except Trail and Lead line.
- High Point Ribbon awarded to competitors that attend both shows that have accumulated the most points in English, Western and Dressage division.
- 8. Additional High Point ribbon awarded to Standardbred and Thoroughbred accumulating the most points and competing in both shows.
- 9. Martingales are not permitted in under saddle classes.
- 10. Appropriate schooling attire is required, heeled boot and ASTM certified helmet required whenever mounted. IN ADDITION, EVERYONE UNDER 18 MUST WEAR A HELMET IN ORDER TO COMPETE IN ANY CLASS, INCLUDING WESTERN DIVISIONS.
- 11. The Horse Park of New Jersey, its owners, operators, employees, and other entities will not be responsible for damage, injury, or loss to any person, animal or property of exhibitors or spectators occurring at this show.
- 12. Dogs must be on a leash. \$20 NO LEASH FINE
- 13. There is no haul-in fee for these shows. Please use appropriate trash and manure containers
